Rules and Conduct Code

Skaters are expected to conduct themselves in a way which insures their safety and the safety of all others. Friday night session is a lock-in – all skaters under the age of 16 are expected to stay for the entire session. Those wishing to leave early must have a parent COME IN TO the building to pick them up. There are no in and out privileges. If you leave, you may not re-enter. Everyone entering the building will pay admission and put skates on. Parents and infants are the only exception.
